

The History of Mustang Football

Football began at Grand Valley in the fall of 1962. The first season consisted of 5 games and our first ever victory was a 14-0 decision over the Cardinal Huskies JV team. The first varsity win came in 1963, a 18-12 decision over Pymatuning Valley.

It took 5 years for the Mustangs to win their first conference title in 1966. The Mustangs, led by Head Coach Joe Shoaf and tight end Ron Chutas tied for the G.L.A.C. championship with Newbury. Since that first conference championship in 1966 the Mustangs have won or shared 8 other championships: 1978, 1979, 1980, 1986, 1987, 1992, 1996, and 1997.

Included in team records are 4 appearances in the state playoffs.: 1986 (losing to the Hawken Hawks and O.J. McDuffie), 1996, 1997, and 1999. The lone victory in the playoffs was a 45-6 victory over South Range in 1997.

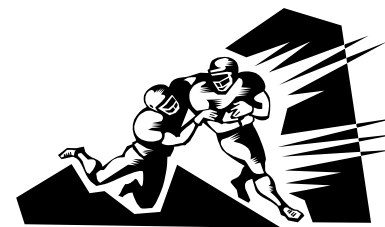
The Mustangs have had 11 All-State players: Tom Zakowski running back 1968, Jim Dyke offensive tackle 1979, Mick Shoaf offensive tackle 1986, Lowell Moodt offensive tackle 1987, Ed Daugherty running back 1991, Nathan Chutas offensive tackle 1992, John Delzoppo running back 1993, Pat Mooney running back 1993 and 1994, Ralph Childs running back 1996, Al Rubosky linebacker 1997, and Nick Henderlight running back 2005.

Grand Valley and Pymatuning Valley have shared a "Traveling Trophy" since 1978. G.V. leads the series 19 to 5.
